COVER:New York, Ontario, and Western 4-8-2 No. 405 , the Mountaineer, near Olive Street Crossing in Scranton in May, 1941 (color)

JAN:Scranton Transit Company No. 420 inbound to downtown Scranton, crossing the Spruce Street Bridge in February, 1946 .

FEB:Wilkes-Barre Railway Corporation Nos. 768, 756, 764, and 790 on Public Square at Market

Street and South Main Street in Wilkes-Barre in May 1940 MAR:An Erie railroad locomotive pulling a local freight eastbound on the Wyoming Division in Dunmore in mid 1940's

APR:Scranton Transit Company No. 502 and another car in the 353-362 series on Wyoming Avenue near Lackawanna Avenue in Scranton in September, 1937

MAY:Erie Lackawanna SD-45-2 No, 3679 and an unidentified locomotive pull train Advanced Croxton-99 west through Scranton near Keyser Avenue in July 1974

JUN:Lackawanna & Wyoming Valley No. 403 passing the Pittston Station on Market Street traveling northbound in 1951 JULY:An unidentified Delaware Lackawanna & Western steam locomotive leads a passenger train eastbound through Dunmore in late 1940's

AUG:Lehigh Valley PA's No 609 and 605 pull No. 10, the Black Diamond, along the Susquehanna River in Port Griffith in October, 1955

SEPT:A Lackawanna & Wyoming Valley freight pulled by DL&W No. 434 near Laurel Street in Pittston Township in July, 1955

OCT:Penn Central GP-38 No. 7793 pulls a special ten car train with 2 heat exchangers at the South Street Bridge in Wilkes-Barre in February, 1975

NOV:Delaware & Hudson RS-3 No. 4075 and a special inspection train approach the crossing at Herrick Center, PA in November, 1977

DEC:Scranton Railway Company No. 334 poses for a photo along the Petersburg line in Scranton in 1910

EXTRA:A collection of passenger and freight cars near the former Central Railroad of New Jersey Railroad Station in Wilkes-Barre in December, 1977

EXTRA:Wilkes-Barre Railway Corporation Cars No. 356, 710, and 716, all inbound, on Wyoming Avenue at Shoemaker Street in Forty Fort in May, 1939 , including photographer Edward S. Miller

Purchase of this calendar helps the Lackawanna & Wyoming Valley Railway Historical Society accomplish many goals. We are donating books on local railroad history to public libraries throughout Northeastern Pennsylvania.
